

# CAN MLYNEDD O AROLYGU A CHOFNODI ONE HUNDRED YEARS OF SURVEY AND RECORD

Sefydlwyd Comisiwn Brenhinol Henebion Cymru ar 10 Awst 1908. Bellach, mae'n Gorff a Noddir gan Lywodraeth y Cynulliad, a hwn yw'r sefydliad cenedlaethol sy'n gyfrifol am arolygu a chofnodi safleoedd, adeiladweithiau, tirweddau ac olion morol, archaeolegol a hanesyddol yng Nghymru.

Ei rôl bwysicaf yw curaduro Cofnod Henebion Cenedlaethol Cymru, sef yr archif awdurdodol o amgylchedd hanesyddol Cymru. Yn y Cofnod Henebion Cenedlaethol ceir adroddiadau a darluniadau sy'n ffrwyth prosiectau'r Comisiwn Brenhinol ynghyd â deunyddiau a roddwyd iddo gan ymchwilwyr amatur a phroffesiynol, cyrff masnachol fel practisiau pensaerniol, Cadw, Ymddiriedolaethau Archaeolegol Cymru a sefydliadau academaidd. Ei gryfderau arbennig yw ei gasgliadau helaeth o awyrluniau a mapiau.

The Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Wales was established on 10 August 1908.

It is now an Assembly Government Sponsored Body and is the national organisation responsible for surveying and recording archaeological and historical sites, structures, landscapes and maritime remains in Wales.

Its most important role is the curatorship of the National Monuments Record of Wales, the authoritative archive of the historic environment of Wales. The National Monuments Record contains reports and illustrations from the Royal Commission's projects and materials donated by amateur and professional researchers, commercial bodies such as architectural practices, Cadw, the Welsh Archaeological Trusts and academic institutions. Particular strengths are its extensive collections of aerial photographs and maps.

This exhibition illustrates some of the Royal Commission's current research and outreach programmes.

The National Monuments Record is the home of the large number of written, graphical and photographic records created by the Royal Commission in the last hundred years.






The National Monuments Record contains a great variety of written, graphical and photographic records donated to it by individuals, government and educational bodies and private businesses. Its special collections include vertical and oblique aerial photography and historic maps.

Un o'r ffyrdd gorau o ddechrau deall safle archaeolegol yw gwneud arolwg topograffig manwl ohono. Bob blwyddyn, bydd y Comisiwn Brenhinol yn gwneud arolygon o safleoedd sydd dan fgythiad neu o bwys cenedlaethol.

One of the best ways to begin to understand an archaeological site is to make a detailed topographic survey of it. Annually the Royal Commission carries out surveys of sites under threat or of national importance.

Aerial photography is a powerful way to document the landscapes of Wales from prehistory to the present. Every year the Royal Commission's aerial archaeologist discovers long-hidden sites and provides new perspectives on known monuments and the buildings of our towns and countryside.

The Royal Commission's survey programmes deal with themes of national or regional interest in current archaeology and architectural and industrial history. The Royal Commission also maintains a unit to survey significant buildings threatened with demolition or substantial alteration.




Royal Commission staff travel all over Wales to make presentations and give advice.

The Library and Enquiries Service can deal with enquiries by mail, telephone or electronically, and visitors are welcome at its office in Aberystwyth, individually or in groups.




