Summary

This report comprises of an Archaeological Watching Brief undertaken during ground disturbance works necessary for the erection of two single story extensions to 6 Castle Mews, Caerleon (NGR ST342721 186968).

The Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust - Curatorial Division (GGAT-CD), acting as advisors to Newport City Council (NCC) recommended an archaeological watching brief should be undertaken on all ground works associated with the development as a condition of planning (NCC App.No:16/0691)

The proposed work required archaeological mitigation due to the site being located within an archaeologically sensitive area and in close proximity to the Scheduled Ancient Monuments of the Roman Legionary Fortress and Caerleon Castle.

The watching brief uncovered layers of occupation dating to the Roman Period at 1.18m below current ground level. The full extent of the excavation was 1.92m below current ground level where riverine clay was exposed in the base of the foundation trench.

The initial occupation takes the form of two thin charcoal rich pyrotechnical dumps alternating with stabilization periods. The final stabilization period showed signs of occupation with a moderate and varied assemblage of Roman pottery dating from the 1st-2nd Century A.D. This was capped by a fairly large demolition layer comprising large quantities of Roman tegulae - roof tile - with smaller quantities of Roman brick and imbrex. Two fragments of identifiable box tile was also recovered.

The finds showed little abrasion and the quantity of Roman building debris suggest a substantial Roman structure was in close proximity of the ground works. This building given the date would relate to the canabae - village - attached to the outside of the Roman Legionary Fortress. The single box tile suggests it had a hypocaust and may relate to the civilian bathhouse which is known to reside in the area.

A thick layer of subsoil capped the Roman demolition layer with much later 19th-20th Century pottery recovered. The remaining layers were disturbed through the construction of more recent and current buildings on site, with at least one former 19th Century brick built building appears to have been demolished to make way for the current.

Introduction

This Watching Brief Report has been prepared by Mr Louis Stafford; on behalf of A.P.A.C. Ltd, for Mr S. Jeremiah, in response to a proposed programme of works for the construction of two single story extensions to the existing building of 6 Castle Mews, Caerleon.

The planning proposal application was noted by Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust - Curatorial Division, (henceforth GGAT-CD), acting as archaeological advisers to Newport City Council (henceforth NCC) as having a potential for impact upon archaeological remains. The development work was approved with condition; NPT1357/RD

The proposal will require archaeological mitigation due to the application area being situated close to the legionary Fortress (Cadw ref. MM230) and Caerleon Castle, a scheduled Monument. We also note it is located within the conservation Area and Archaeologically Sensitive area of Newport. Due to the proximity of the proposal to a Scheduled Monument.

NPT1357/RD

The response stated the need for archaeological investigation suggesting that NCC word the condition in line with the Welsh Office Circular 60/96, Section 23:

No development shall take place until the applicant, or their agents or successors in title, has secured agreement for a written scheme of historic environment mitigation which has been submitted by the applicant and approved by the local planning authority. Thereafter, the programme of work will be fully carried out in accordance with the requirements and standards of the written scheme.

Reason: To identify and record any features of archaeological interest discovered during the works, in order to mitigate the impact of the works on the archaeological resource.

NPT1357/RD

The Chartered Institute for Archaeologists (henceforth CIfA), standards and guidance require that a Written Scheme of Investigation (henceforth WSI) be submitted to the Local Planning Authority to provided a framework for the archaeological watching brief. WSI: WB/CMC/16 was prepared by A. Phillips, APAC Ltd., at the request of the client. The WSI was subsequently given approval and work commenced on October 17th 2016 (Appendix VII).

The archaeological Watching brief conformed to the *Standards and Guidance for an Archaeological Watching Brief* (CIfA 2014) and *Standards and Guidance for Archaeological Artefact and Environmental Collection, documentation, Conservation and Research* (CIfA).

The project was managed by Dr N. Phillips (Director), APAC Ltd with site work undertaken by Louis Stafford.

Site Location, Topography and Geology

The watching brief is centred on NGR ST 42721 186968, 6 Castle Mews, Caerleon, Newport, NP18 1BY (Fig 1).

The development area lies on the southern bank of the River Usk, at the southern end of the village of Caerleon. The land slips away gently toward the south and rises steeply toward the north. The site is bounded to the north east by Castle Street. To the east and west of site, further housing is prominent; lying on a similar contour which would have formed the flood plain of the River Usk.

The solid geology at the site is St Maughans Formation – Argillaceous rocks and (subequal/subordinate) interbedded Sandstone. Sedimentary bedrock formed approximately 398 to 416 million years ago in the Devonian period. Local environment previously dominated by rivers. (British Geological Survey 2001).

The superficial geology comprises riverine silts and clays.



Brief archaeological and historical background

A 500m diameter search centred on the proposed site was commissioned from the Historic Environment Record (HER): appendices I-II-III. The search map (Fig 3-4), shows the concentration of both Core and Event records around the site, as provided by the HER. The concentration and numerous event and core records, of which there are too many to list here, show the archaeologically sensitive nature of the area.

The paucity of prehistoric finds is possibly due to the substantial development of Caerleon during the Roman period. However, there is some Iron Age occupation in the form of Lodge Wood Hillfort (GGAT Ref:00597g), dating to around 600-300 BC, located approximately 1km north west of site. The hillfort is later re-occupied in the Roman period by the Legion and used as a summer camp.

The Roman period in Caerleon starts around AD 75 with the construction of the Legionary Fortress (Cadw ref:MM230) by the Second Augustan Legion. Initially an earth and timber rampart but later of stone. Later additions of an amphitheatre (Cadw Ref:MM232) in 80 AD and the permanence of the Legion in the area attracted a large civilian settlement or *canabae*, (Cadw Ref:MM231) which formed around the Fortress. The settlements are located in almost all directions around the Fortress with one located 100m to the east of site (Cadw ref. MM244) and similarly to the west where a port was constructed near to the amphitheatre. Gravestones and burials dating from the Roman period have been recovered south of Caerleon and the River Usk; continuing from Belmont Hill toward Bulmore along the ridge line. The Legionary Fortress appears to have been abandoned in the 3rd Century AD by the Legion with little further occupation noted past the late 4th Century.

The Medieval Period sees a second hiatus with the construction of a Norman defensive motte of Caerleon castle (Cadw ref:MM014), located just north of site. The castle itself; built upon the already situated Roman fortress, is thought to have begun as a timber motte and bailey castle, later converted to masonry with a defensive curtain wall, barbican and three stone towers. The castle motte, was also apparently surmounted by a round tower which collapsed in 1793. Of the three known defensive towers, only one survives; incorporated within the building "The Hanbury Arms", a 16th Century grade II listed building (Cadw Ref: Building ID: 2995).

The Church of St Cadoc's, grade II* listed building (Cadw Ref: Building ID: 2948), is also added to during the Norman period but its foundation was of probable early Christian/Roman date. Medieval occupation outside of the Norman castle continues as shown by occupation and find spots scattered throughout the village. Medieval occupation is also known in the neighbouring settlements across the river which was linked by a bridge with opposing towers; one of which is built into the afore mentioned Hanbury Arms.

Occupation of Caerleon therefore continues up and through the Post Medieval period to modern times, fairly uninterrupted, with a hiatus firmly in the Roman period and to lesser extremes in the Medieval and Post Medieval periods.

Cartographic documentation provides little further information, but it does however identity a former building located on site which appears on the First Edition 1882 OS 1:2500 (Fig 3). A single long east west range crosses the site, with a small southern range at the eastern end and central, with a third larger toward the western end. The northern side had a small annex toward the western end with a small return noted along the northern edge, half way along.

The 1900 Edition OS map 6 Inch shows less detail than the previous map, with a single rectangular block of similar dimensions orientated east to west (Fig 4).

The 1917 Edition OS map 6 Inch shows some changes from the 1882. The east west range is shown as two separate buildings with the western building almost three times the length of the eastern building, with a small parcel of land between the two (Fig 5).

The 1938 and 1949 Edition OS map 6 Inch shows no changes to that of the previous 1917 map (Fig 6-7).

The 1972, 1977 and 1989 1:10000 OS Edition maps were also examined, but the resolution was too low to determine any changes, but none were apparent.



Aims and Objectives

The aim of the watching brief was to preserve by record, within the resources available, any archaeological deposits uncovered during groundwork.

The watching brief also ensured that: in the event of archaeological resources of significance, being discovered and requiring treatment beyond the remit of the watching brief, that steps would be implemented to ensure that their treatment would be undertaken within the standards recommended by the CIfA.

Methodology

The concrete paved patio which was encountered across the area of Trench 1 was removed with a tracked 360 machine excavator with a toothed bucket. The aggregate and overburden were then removed with a toothless grading bucket.

Initially, a standard slot foundation was cut against the house to ascertain the level of the current foundations and the depth of the natural (Pl 3). The work encountered archaeology of Roman date at a depth of approximately 1.2m below current ground level, with the natural at 1.85m (Pl 5). The contractors then deemed that a foundation raft would be the preferred option instead of conventional slot foundations and excavation was adjusted to suit.

The overburden for the raft foundation was removed by a 360°, mini digger, using a toothless grading bucket, in spits down to a maximum depth of 0.6m below current ground level. The same formation level was imposed on Trench 2.

The trench locations were related back to the House and boundaries and all heights were recorded back to OD. Recording was carried out using APAC Ltd recording systems (pro-forma context sheets etc), using a continuous sequence for all contexts.

Written, drawn and photographic records of an appropriate level of detail were maintained throughout the course of the project. Digital photographs were taken using cameras with resolutions of 18 mega pixels or above.

Plans and sections were drawn to a scale of 1:20 scale.

Watching Brief

Presentation Notes:

All contexts are denoted as a [#Cut] and (#Fill) in the text, listed in Appendix IV, cross referenced in Appendix V, to the plates section.

Photographs used in the text are listed Pl # and a complete list of photographs can be found in appendix V with contact sheets.

The watching brief was undertaken during a single day: 17th October 2016. The conditions were favourable however, the excavation work encountered some difficulties when a water main was broken, early during the undertaking. This was followed later with encroaching ground water at the base of the trench, when the water table was reached.

Trench 1

Trench 1 was located against the south-east elevation of 6 Castle Mews, measuring 6.2m by 3.9m, orientated approximately north-east to south-west (Fig 2). The trench area was level and covered in modern concrete patio slabs. The initial excavation was to a depth of approximately 0.5m across the trench (Pl 1). The excavation then continued down to a depth of 1.92m for a length of 3.9m along the north east edge of Trench 1 (Pl 2). A small return along the south east edge over a length of 2.4m was also excavated (Fig 10-12, Pl 2-6).



At the base of the excavation, riverine clay (01) was exposed. This was a light grey soft plastic clay, very well sorted low energy alluvial deposit with a horizontal clast orientation. No stone inclusions were apparent and no archaeological features were present cut into the natural.

Overlying the riverine clay (01) was a series of pyrotechnical dumps (02), (04) with periods of stabilisation (03), (05) where vegetation briefly appeared to take hold. The pyrotechnical dumps (02) and (04) consisted of a dark brown to black moderately firm silty clay with some alluvial sorting as the clast orientation appeared horizontal. Large quantities of charcoal and ash were present forming the majority of the context. No stone inclusions appeared present. The contexts (02) & (04) appeared to represent burning episodes in the vicinity with a deliberate rapid deposition over the area to a maximum depth of 0.05m. A stabilisation period of dark brown silty clay, 0.1m in depth, split the two pyrotechnical dumps. This context, (03), was moderately firm with some moderately sized alluvial components; well sorted with rare rounded inclusions probably representative of a period of vegetation briefly taking hold. Overlying pyrotechnical dump (04) was a second stabilisation period (05); similar to context (03).

The stabilisation period context (05) was dark brown moderately firm silty clay, 0.4m in depth, with some alluvial sorting, with rare rounded stone inclusions. This context produced a large quantity of varied Roman pottery finds, a single animal bone and some fragments of imbrex. The finds themselves showed little signs of abrasion suggesting a deliberate dumping of domestic wares with little movement. Overlying context (05) was (06).

Context (06) was a mid orangey brown, firm silty clay, with little to no orientation, with rare large rounded and angular stone inclusions. The majority of the context was formed by Roman CBM including brick, *tegulae*, imbrex and box tile. A small assemblage of Roman ceramics was also present. This context appears to represent a collapsed Roman building in the vicinity, presumably given the slight tipping toward the south, it was located north of the trench.

Overlying context (06), was a dark red brown, moderately firm silty clay, (07) 0.12m in depth, with some alluvial sorting and rare rounded stone inclusions. This appeared to be a remnant subsoil. No finds were noted. Overlying (07) was a thick 0.35m in depth subsoil (08), a dark grey brown friable silty clay with some sand content, moderate energy, little sorting with no clast orientation and a moderate amount of stone inclusions. Some ash lenses were present toward the top of the context. Presumably given the depth below ground this would represent the Medieval/Post Medieval subsoil; however, no finds were noted.

Overlying context (08) was a mid orangey brown, moderately firm, unsorted rapid made ground (09), 0.4m in depth. The context had large amounts of modern building rubble and appeared to represent a demolished Post Medieval building in the area. The majority of the material was 20th-21st Century CBM with some residual Roman CBM present and Caerleon Forge brick was also present. Clear glass and blue and white print ceramic were also recovered. This context appears to relate to the construction of the current building on site having impacted down to the Roman layers when the foundations for 6 Castle Mews were cut. The previous building and ant excess soil were used to level the ground to the south east of the building.

Overlying context (09) was a modern subsoil (10), mid red grey, unsorted silty clay, 0.28m in depth with large quantities of angular stone inclusions. Modern CBM and ceramics were noted. Cutting this context were two modern service trenches [15], a water pipe and [13], the foul sewer. Capping the trench was a thin layer of aggregate bedding (11) for the concrete slab patio (12).

The conventional slot trench was abandoned in favour for a raft given the density of Roman finds encountered. The remainder of the trench was excavated down to a depth of 0.6m exposing context (09) (PI 2).

Trench 2

Trench 2 was located against the north-west elevation of 6 Castle Mews, measuring 4.3m by 2.2m, orientated approximately north-east to south-west (Fig 2). The trench area was level and covered in modern topsoil (21). The trench was excavated down to a depth of 0.6m (Fig 13-14, PI 7-8).

At the base of the trench, a modern building debris/subsoil (20) was exposed. This was dark grey friable silty clay, very little sorting, rapid deposit with moderate amounts of stone inclusions mixed with modern CBM. No archaeological features were present cut into (20) apart from the foundation trench for the current building. Overlying (20) was a thin layer of dark brown, loamy, modern topsoil.



Finds

An assemblage of 68 fragments of pottery were recovered during the watching brief. Two fragments were of post-medieval date and the remainder were Roman; 1st-2nd century AD. An assemblage of 63 fragments of CBM was recovered. Two fragments were post-medieval in date the remainder were Roman 1st-2nd century AD (Appendix VI).

The assemblage from Castle Mews presents a number of points of interest. Remarkable is the low percentage of any post-Roman pottery. On most sites in and around Caerleon, one can expect a wide range of post-medieval pottery, and even some medieval. This site has two post-medieval sherds, probably 19th to 20th century material, suggesting that it has been largely unoccupied, flooded or used as pasture over the last 1600 years.

The bias toward roof construction material was notable with 40 fragments of *tegulae* and 14 fragments of imbrex (crests). The complete absence of any legion stamps, given the large quantity recovered, could suggest an early date in the forts history, late 1st early second century AD, rather than a later.

Three fragments of *tegulae* featured chamfered edges on the underside with a single square notched piece also recovered. The flanges were varied as was the material used in their construction, with only a few heavily abraded fragments. Suggesting a single collapse episode of a roof that had seen maintenance and repair.

Four *tegulae* featured finger rings, one featuring three rings, one featuring four rings and two had a single ring. A single piece of floor brick also featured four rings.

Context (05) produced substantial portions of single pots suggesting that these found their way into the ground complete or near complete. Little abrasion was shown if any possibly suggesting that the context was fairly rapid and helped by inundation from the river.

An un-documented form of Caerleon Ware from the Abernant Kiln was also recovered from the same context. This bowl takes a similar form to previously known bowls from the same series but has a larger flanged rim. Two simple horizontal bands form the decoration around the centre of the bowl. The base was not recovered. A black burnished flat rimmed and grooved bowl was also recovered with horizontal line decoration. A fragment of *mortaria* with spout and simple banding on the base and a single handled water jug of local production was also recovered.

The nature of the pottery assemblage as a whole suggests a domestic assemblage. Kitchen wares predominate although the lack of animal bone was notable. A single fragment of Dressel 20 amphora, associated with olive oil and a single Samian sherd being the only fine ware present.

Indications as to the chronological and economic/social outline of the site are fairly limited. Among the Roman pottery, material is present from the first to second century, favouring the early second century reign of Hadrian (117-138 AD); suggested by Dr Mark Lewis of the Nation Roman Legion Museum. The CBM recovered, represents a large quantity, suggesting a building in close proximity; possibly with a hypocaust and brick floor as suggested by the remains of two box tiles and a handful of brick fragments.

The remains of the building appear to have been disturbed by later 20th century construction as a fragment of frogged brick from the Caerleon brick forge are located in context (09), alongside that of Roman *tegulae*.



Conclusion

Trench 1 impacted down to the natural riverine clays (01). A layer of pyrotechnical dump (02), overlay the natural clays, which was followed by a short period of stabilisation where plant growth took hold and a subsoil (03), albeit shallow in depth formed. This layer was followed by another pyrotechnical dump (04) underlying another stabilisation period where plant growth was established and a subsoil (05) formed.

The subsoil layer (05), had the earliest datable context considering the Roman pottery recovered. The pottery itself was typical of domestic assemblages, however there was an absence of bone. The pottery itself was fairly un-abraded and many of the sherds belonged to the same pot suggesting a fairly rapid if not deliberate segregation of domestic waste in this area; favouring pottery rather than a typical cross section of domestic debris. Three sherds of imbrex (crest) were also found within this context and may suggest that the roof structure, which is apparent in the overlying context (06), may have already begun to collapse or this may suggest small scale maintenance.

Context (06) is potentially debris from a Roman building collapse. Given the small glimpse of the context, it is not possible to determine if this is an *insitu* deposit or partially sorted. However, given the depth, clast orientation and the tipping nature of the context, it is suggestive of a roof collapse from a nearby building. The lack of other CBM or building material would indicate the roof tipped externally of the building and the walls collapsed inwardly. The two fragments of box tile and the five fragments of floor brick from the same context, may suggest the building had a hypocaust and brick floor.

If indeed the building had a hypocaust, it may have a bearing on the pyrotechnical dumps (02) and (04) and these may have been associated with maintaining the buildings heat source. Dr Mark Lewis suggests there was a bathhouse in this area belonging to the *canabae* and the evidence gleaned from Trench 1 would fit this.

The finds from (05) and (06) show food preparation took place in the vicinity, with the recovery of *mortaria*, oil was also apparent with a fragment of amphora, with water jugs and decorated bowls also apparent. The only fine ware was a single sherd of undecorated Samian bowl. The finds from below the Roman building debris and within the debris itself are approximately 1st to 2nd century AD, which is early in the lifespan of the fortress.

The overlying deposits were largely formed through remnant subsoils, with a modern 'made ground' (09), formed when the current building was constructed. This appears; given the cartographic evidence, to have demolished a Post-Medieval structure, which probably was a later add on to that structure, utilising bricks from the Caerleon brick forge. This disturbance managed to impact down to the Roman layer (06) as Roman *tegulae* were recovered from this context.

Trench 2 was negative for archaeological finds or features pre-dating the 20th century.

The watching brief provided a small window into the Roman *canabae* which clung to the outside of the fortress of Caerleon in the 1st to 2nd century AD. This structure featured brick floors and Roman *tegulae* and imbrex on the roof, with the possibility of a hypocaust, suggesting the structure may have been part of the bathhouse. Samian ware from the continent was imported as was oil from Spain, with decorated bowls from Dorset. Food was prepared in locally produced *mortaria*, suggesting a well-connected and thriving structure, integrated into the Roman empire and well established within South Wales.

Post Ex

Following the watching brief, the field notes and photographs were digitised to produce the context record of the stratigraphy; Appendix IV, and an annotated list of the photographs, Appendix V.

The finds were washed by hand, dried, identified, photographed and packed in sealed and labelled bags and recorded in Appendix VI.

The Appendices Context Register IV, Photographs V and Finds VI were cross referenced ready for inclusion in the report.

All finds were deposited with the National Roman Legion Museum Wales.

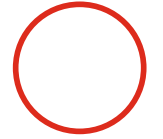
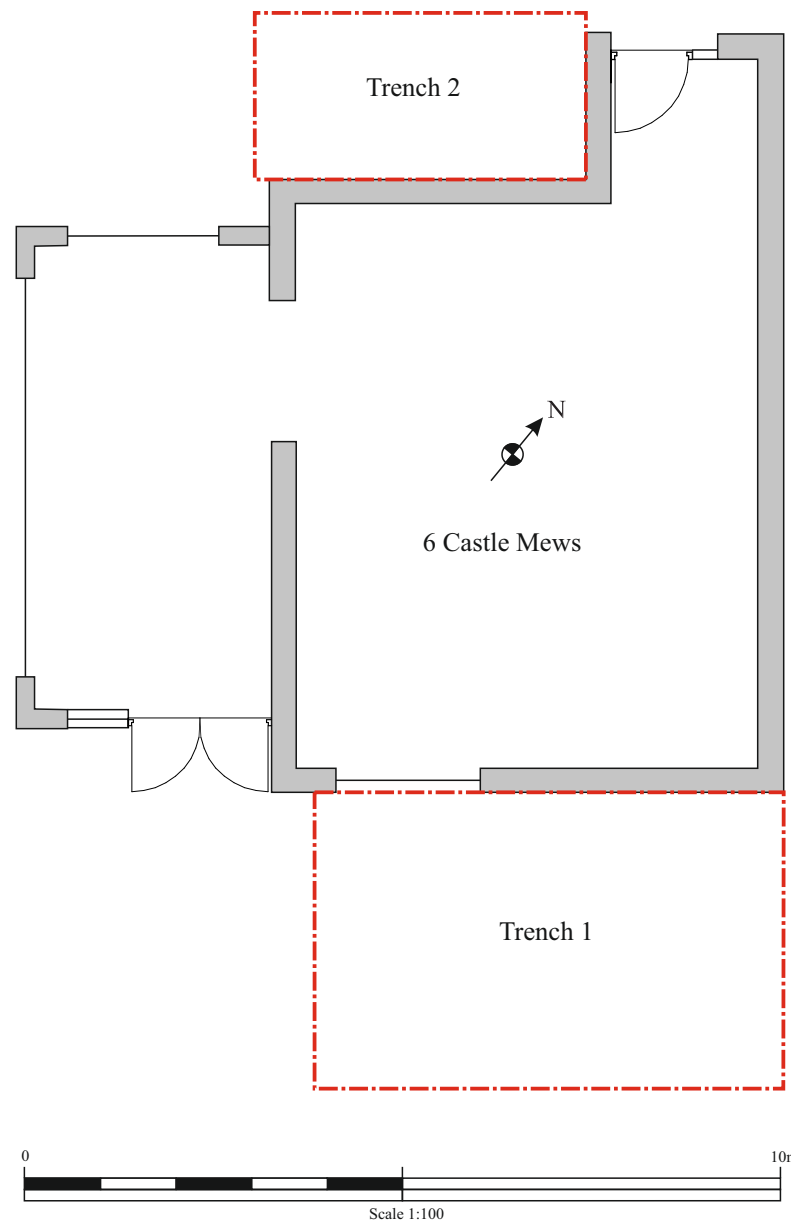


Fig 1: Site Location

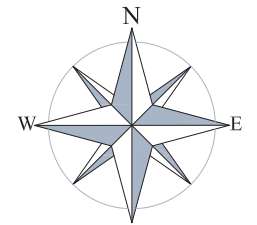

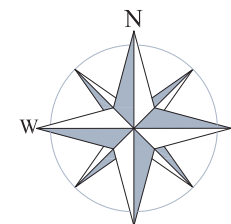

Fig 3: 1882 Edition OS Map 6 Inch



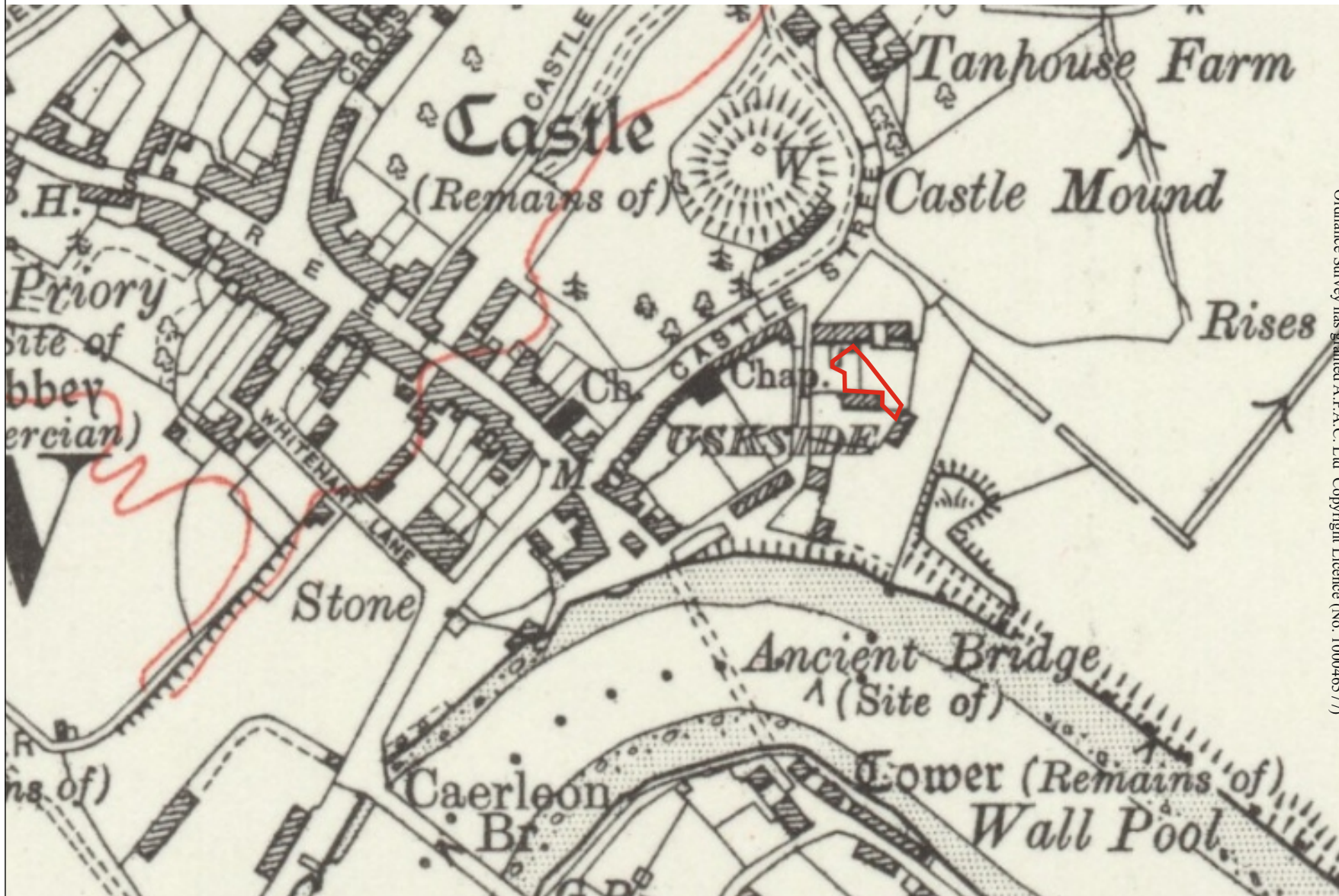

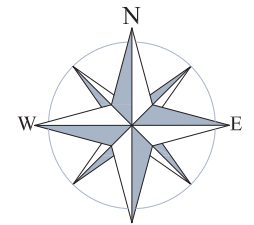

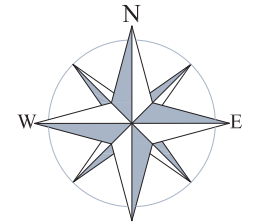

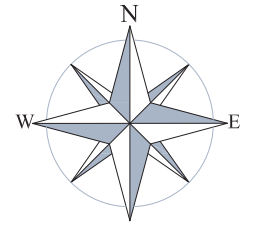

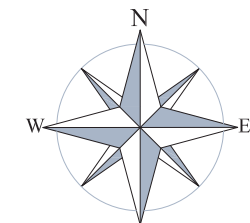
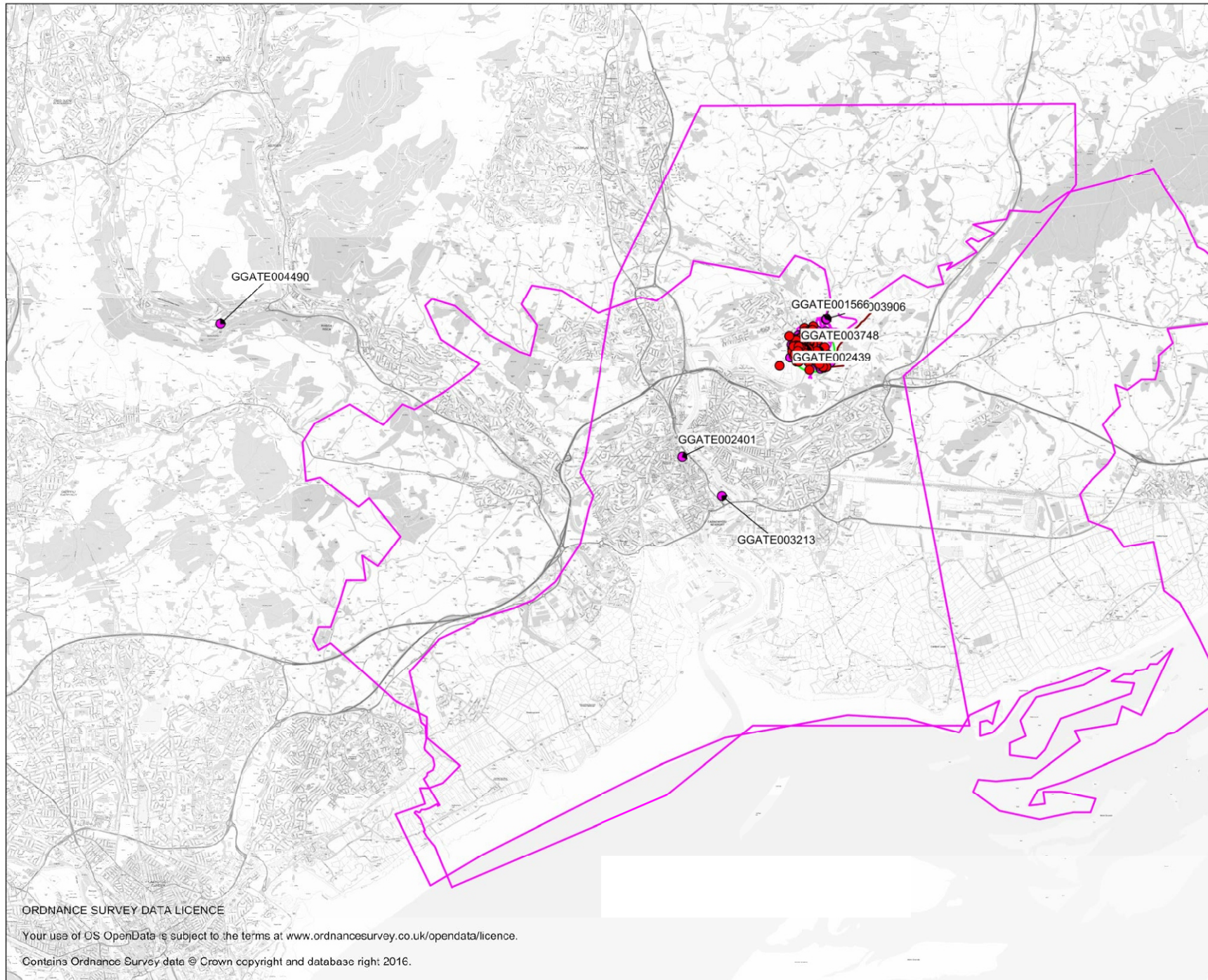






Fig 8: HER Core Overview Map

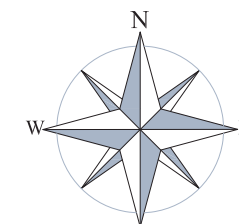
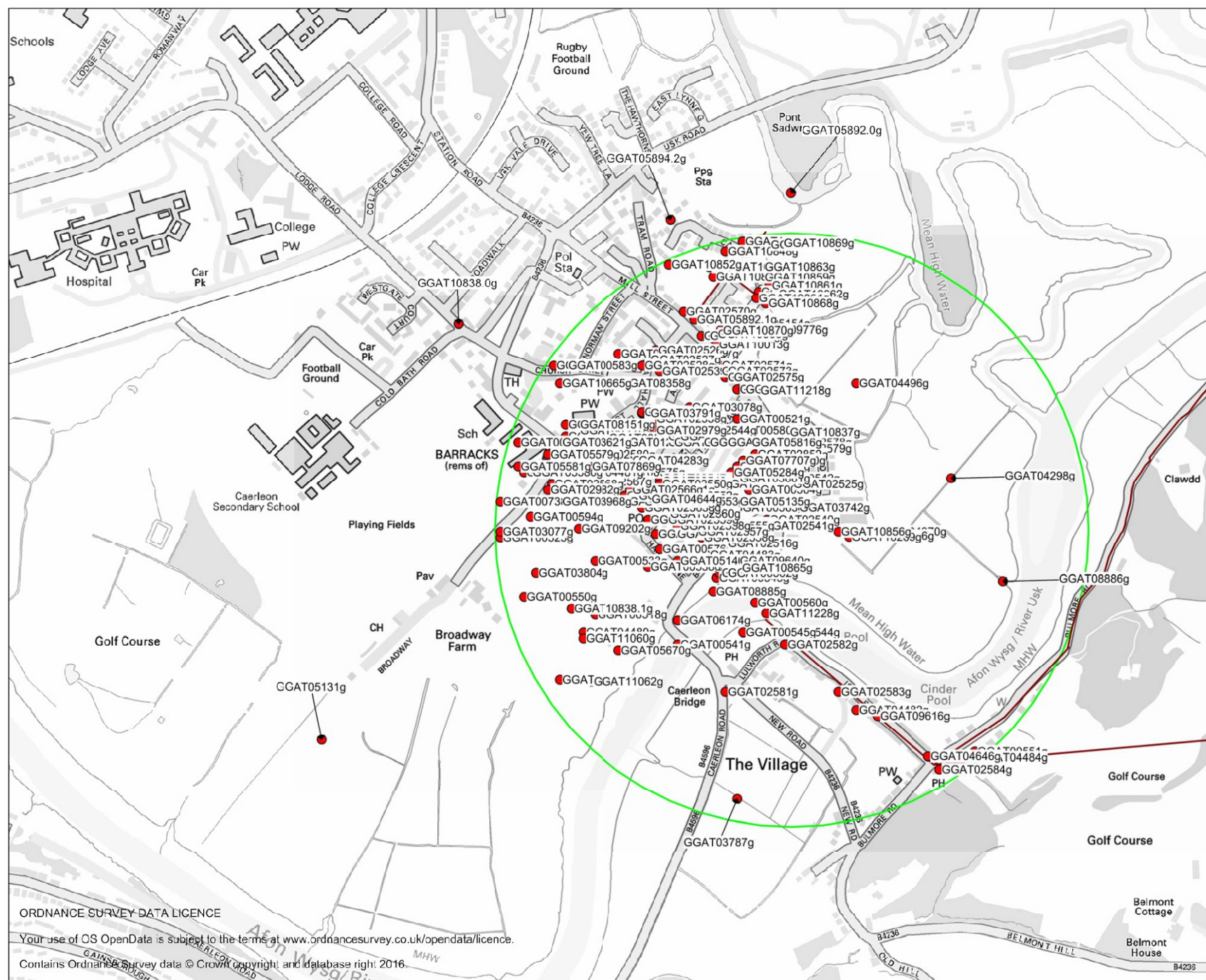







Fig 9: HER Event Overview Map

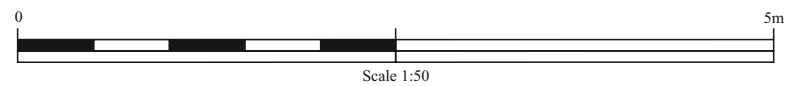
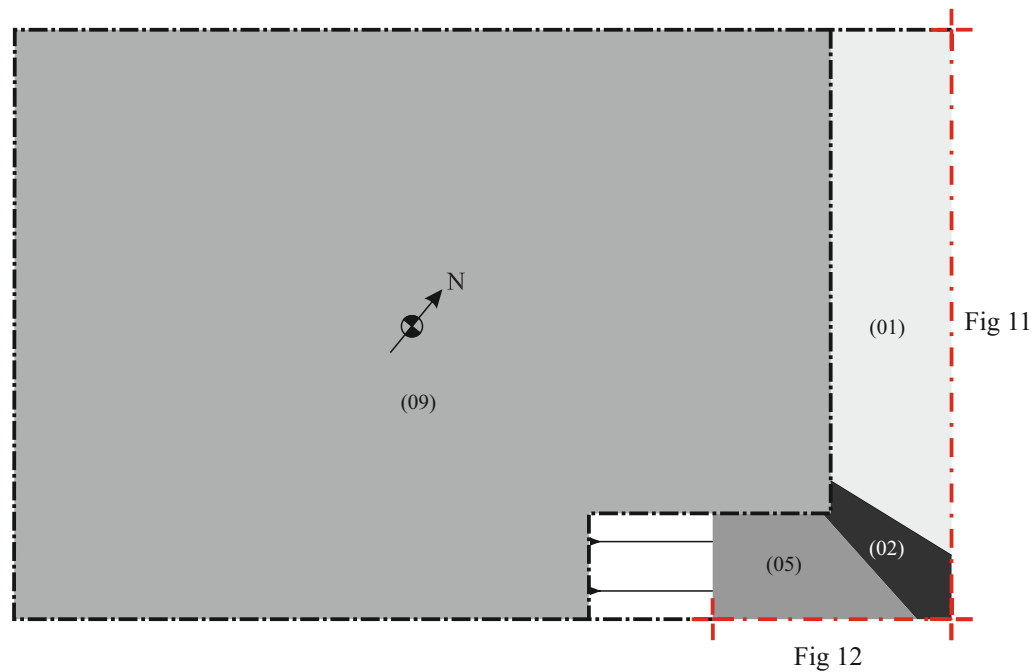


Fig 10: Trench 1 Plan Drawing

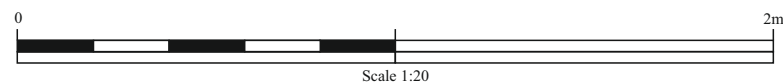
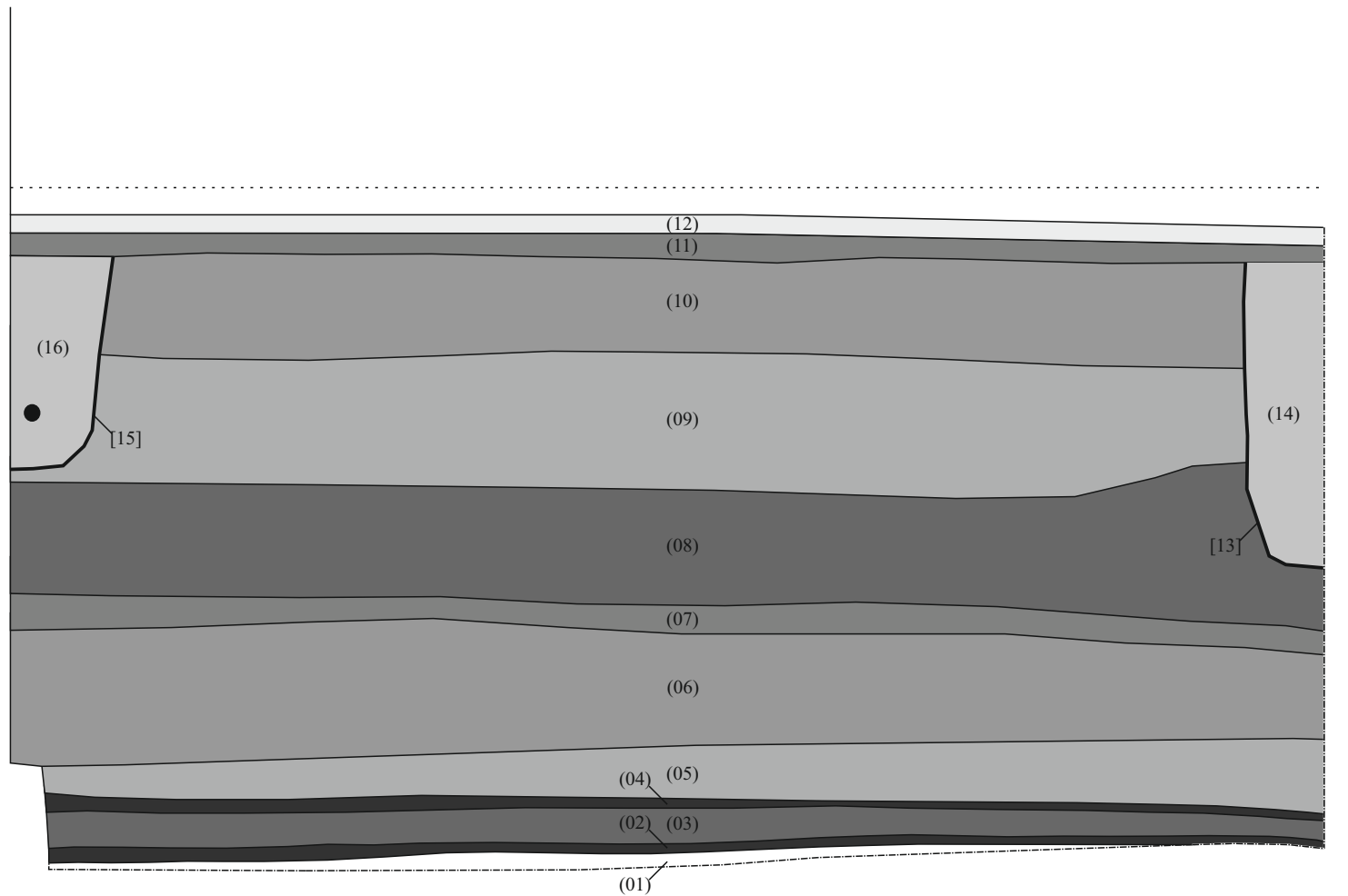


Fig 11: Trench 1 South

Drawing

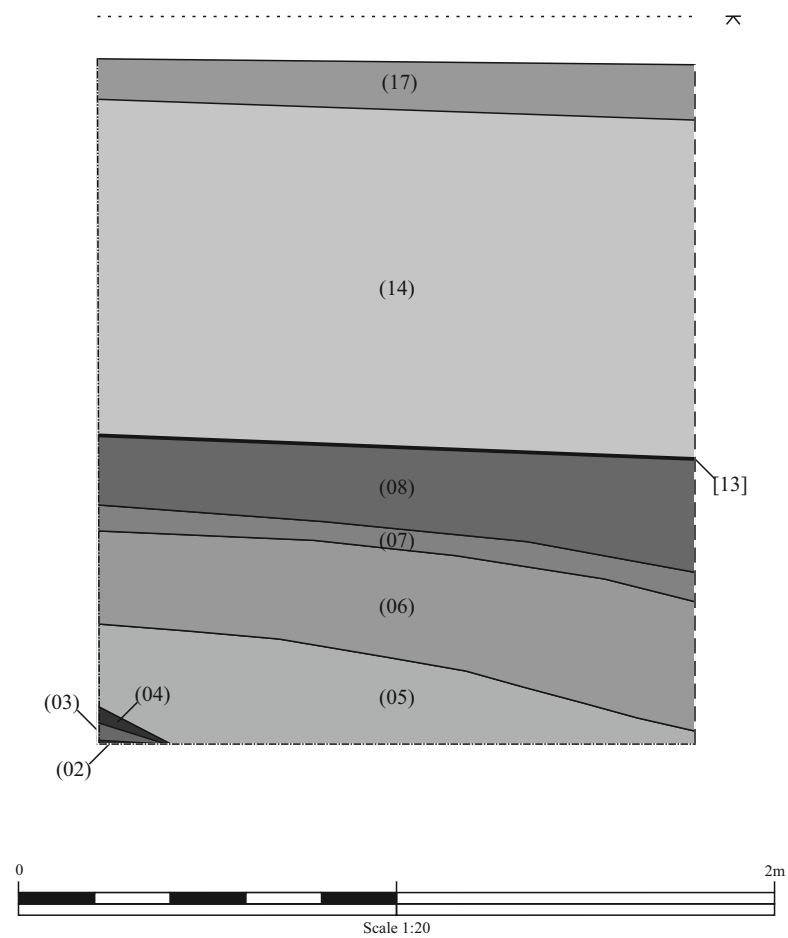


Fig 12: Trench 1 North

Drawing

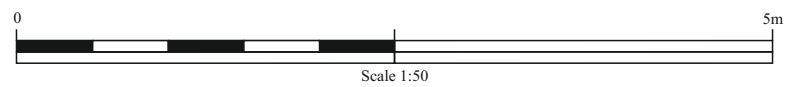
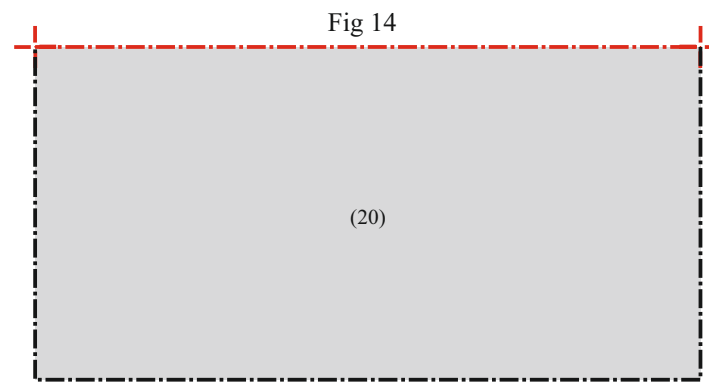


Fig 13: Trench 2 Plan Drawing

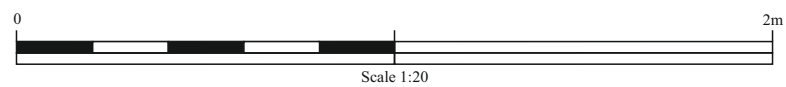
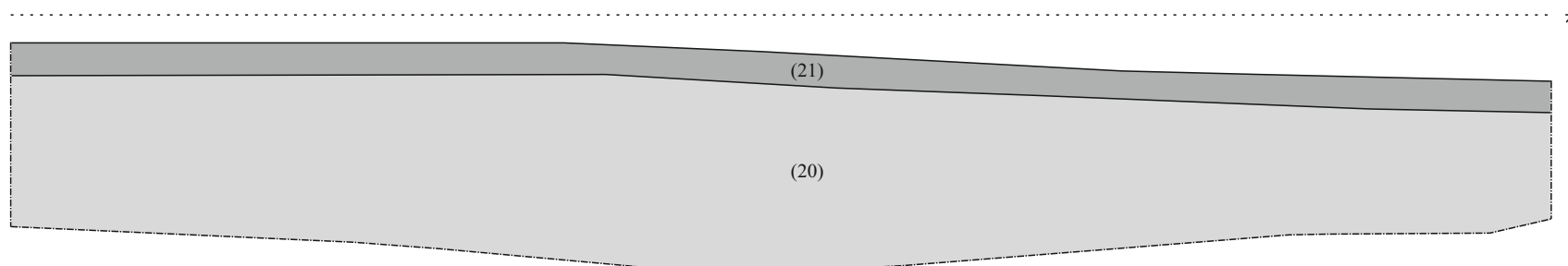


Fig 14: Trench 2 South
