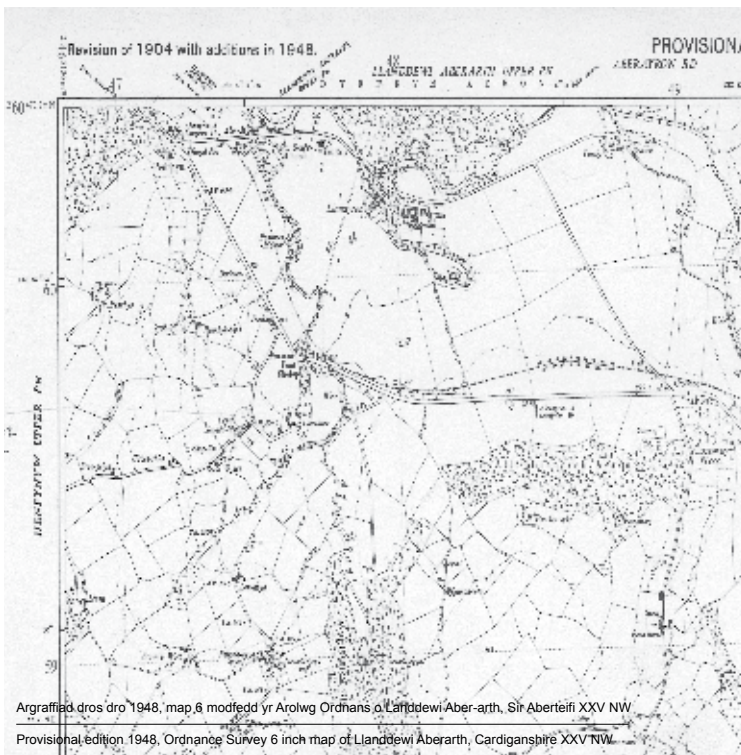




# Tŷ ac Ystâd Llannerchaeron

## Llannerchaeron House and Estate

Yn Nyffryn Aeron, mae Tŷ Llannerchaeron 3 chilometr i'r de-ddwyrain o dref glan-môr Aberaeron. Mae'n eiddo i'r Ymddiriedolaeth Genedlaethol ac yn enghraifft brin o ystâd hunanddigonol o'r ddeunawfed ganrif. Mae tystiolaeth yno sy'n awgrymu i blasty cynharach fod ar yr un safle ac iddo gael ei ddyrchwyl cyn codi Tŷ Llannerchaeron. Heddiw, defnyddir prif fferm yr ystâd yn fferm organig i fagu Gwartheg Duon Cymru, defaid Llanwenog a moch prin o Gymru arni. Mannau braf i grwydro o'u hamgylch yw'r llyn, y gerddi a'r parcdir o gwmpas y tŷ.

Llannerchaeron House, a National Trust property, is a rare example of a self-sufficient eighteen-century estate located within the valley of the Aeron river, 3 kilometers south-east of the coastal town of Aberaeron. There is evidence to suggest that an earlier mansion existed on the same site and was demolished prior to the building of Llannerchaeron House. The Home Farm complex of today is used as a working organic farm rearing Welsh Black Cattle, Llanwenog sheep and rare Welsh pigs. The ornamental lake, pleasure grounds and parkland which surround the House provide ideal walking locations.

Chwith: Sylwch ar y rheilffordd ger Tŷ Llannerchaeron. Adeiladwyd y lein rhwng Llanbedr Pont Steffan ac Aberaeron ym 1911 yn gangen o'r rheilffordd o Gaerfyrddin i Aberystwyth. Dim ond am ddeugain mlynedd y parodd y gwasanaethau i deithwyr ac fe'u diddymwyd mor gynnar â 1951. Daliodd y gwasanaethau nwyddau i redeg am bedair blynedd ar ddeg wedi hynny.

Left: Notice the railway line running close to Llannerchaeron House. This branch line was constructed between Lampeter and Aberaeron in 1911 as part of the Carmarthen to Aberystwyth railway line. Passenger services lasted only forty years and were withdrawn as early as 1951, while freight continued for a further fourteen years.

Uchod: Tŷ Llannerchaeron ym 1997. Cafodd ei gynllunio a'i godi gan John Nash ym 1794, a'r fila hon yw'r enghraifft fwyaf cyflawn o'i waith cynnar. Cyn gweithio ar Llannerchaeron, bu wrthi'n cynllunio carchardai yn Aberteifi, Henffordd a Chaerfyrddin.

Above: Llannerchaeron House in 1997, designed and built by John Nash in 1794. This eighteen-century villa is the most complete example of his early work; prior to his work at Llannerchaeron Nash also designed gaols at Cardigan, Hereford and Carmarthen.

Uchod: Mae cwrn Tŷ Llannerchaeron (a) yn cynnwys llaethdy, golchdy, bragdy a chwt halltu (b), a gerddi muriog y gegin (c). Yn yr adeiladau o amgylch y cwrn mae gwasg gaws wreiddiol o lechi, a phedyll hufen. Mae'n fwy na thebyg mai John Nash a ailwampiodd gynllun Eglwys y Santes Non (d), eglwys y plwyf. Fferm organig yw'r brif fferm (e).

Above: Llannerchaeron House (a) has its own service courtyard with dairy, laundry, brewery and salting house (b), and walled kitchen gardens (c). In the buildings grouped around the service courtyard there are original slate-made cheese presses and cream pans. The parish Church of St Non Church (d) was most likely redesigned by John Nash. The Home Farm complex (e) is a working organic farm.
