Ceredigion's mineral wealth has been exploited since the Bronze Age, but mining reached its peak in the nineteenth century. The remains of copper, lead and silver mines with their associated processing and administrative buildings and hydraulic systems are a characteristic man-made feature of the Ceredigion uplands.
