SUMMARY Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust (projects division) were commissioned to undertake a watching brief at 1 Mill Lane during construction works for a two storey extension to the property.

DESCRIPTION Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust (projects division) were commissioned to undertake a watching brief at 1 Mill Lane during construction works for a two storey extension to the property. The groundwork was undertaken by hand, the foundation trenches averaged 0.60m in width and were between 0.60m and 0.75m in depth. No features or artefacts relating to the Castle situated immediately to the east of the development were recorded. No evidence for occupation prior to the early/mid 19th century was recorded. However presence of an earlier structure in the form of floor levels, demolition debris and rubbish disposal was recorded.

SUMMARY Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust were commissioned by Ogwr Borough Council to carry out an archaeological watching brief. The area of the churchyard produced no archaeological structures although loose gravestones moved for the excavation of the cable-trench were recorded and a few human bones were noted. Finds located within the area of the castle include pottery, glass and iron (Ponsford 1996).

DESCRIPTION Glamorgan Gwent Archaeological Trust were commissioned by Ogwr Borough Council to carry out an archaeological watching brief following their application for scheduled monument consent, listed building consent and a faculty from the church authorities to install a flood-lighting scheme, as part of the 'Lighting up Wales' project. The area of the churchyard produced no archaeological structures although loose gravestones moved for the excavation of the cable-trench were recorded and a few human bones were noted. Finds located within the area of the castle include pottery, glass and iron (Ponsford 1996).

TYPE: sherd **MATERIAL:** pottery **PERIOD:** Post-Medieval **DESCRIPTION:** A sherd of the rim of an open bowl with slip roundels on the rim top found in the topsoil of the churchyard near the south-east corner of the nave, the sherd of pottery is Ewenny-type ware which produced locally to the site. 24 sherds of Ewenny-type ware were found in the cable trench in the castle. These varied from open bowls, jars and jugs, one base sherd of a buff fabric with 'Rockingham'-type iron-rich glaze and one rim of a creamware scalloped bowl (Ponsford 1996).

TYPE: fragment **MATERIAL:** glass **PERIOD:** Post-Medieval **DESCRIPTION:** Glass found on site in a cable trench in castle. The glass found was a neck of a blown 19th-century wine bottle (Ponsford 1996).

TYPE: pin head **MATERIAL:** iron **PERIOD:** U/D **DESCRIPTION:** From cable trench in castle. D-shaped harness buckle lacking pin. 50mm x 55mm.

TYPE: weapon **MATERIAL:** iron **PERIOD:** U/D **DESCRIPTION:** Iron found on site was a flat spike with a pointed head, measures at 220mm in length (Ponsford 1996).
