- 024 RORKE'S DRIFT Ph SOUTH WALL**
- 1 Large brass plaque, set on a wooden base, with inlaid black in an highly decorated border containing all the names of the 1st and 2nd Battalion the South Wales Borderers 24th Regiment who lost their lives at Rorke's Drift in 1879. The plaque is headed by the Regiment's Garland of olive leaves around which is a running ribbon which holds the names of the famous battles encountered, and on each side are the emblems of the Warwickshire Regiment and the South Wales Borderers. The battles listed on the left side are as follows:- BLENHEIM, RAMILIES, OVDENARDE, MALPLAQVET, EGYPT, CAPE OF GOOD HOPE, TALAVERA, FVENTESDONOR, and on the right side, SALAMANCA, VITTORIA, NIVELLE, ORTHES, PENINSULAR, PUNJAUB, CHILLIANWALLAH, GOOJERAT, and in the center at the bottom, the words SOUTH AFRICA.

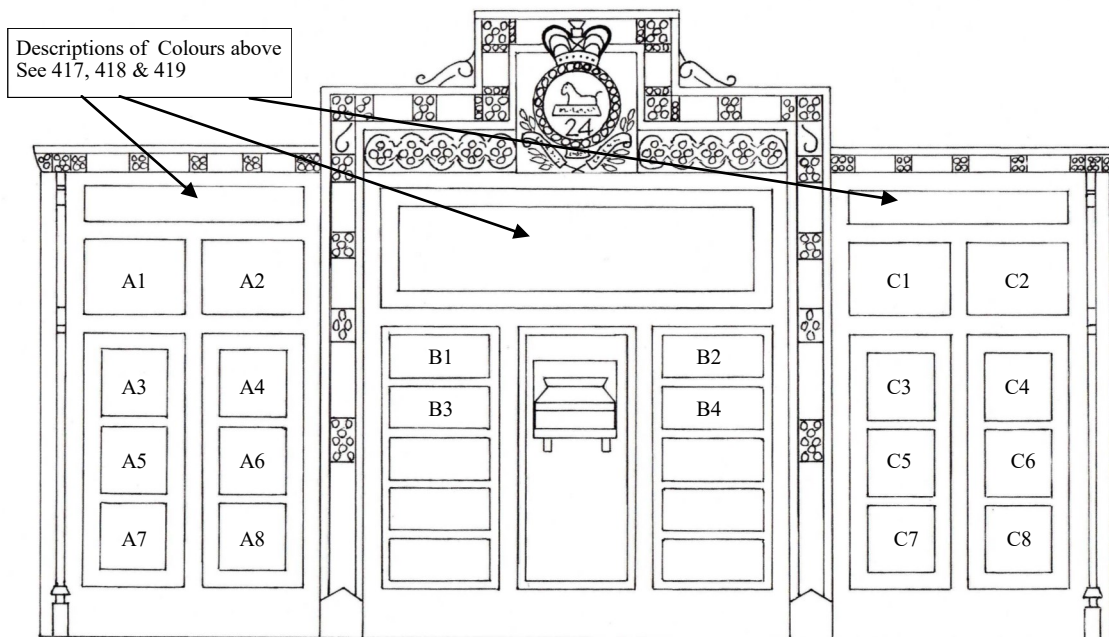

- 1 This series of oak panels with quarter cove moulding are affixed with screws to the decorated wooden panelling. Not all the panels bear inscriptions, but those which do are numbered for detailed reference in 9. The top rectangular panels on each portion bear descriptions of the Colours mounted on poles jutting out from the wall high above each respective panel (refer to 415 for descriptions of the colours, and 308 for the full description of the woodwork).
