

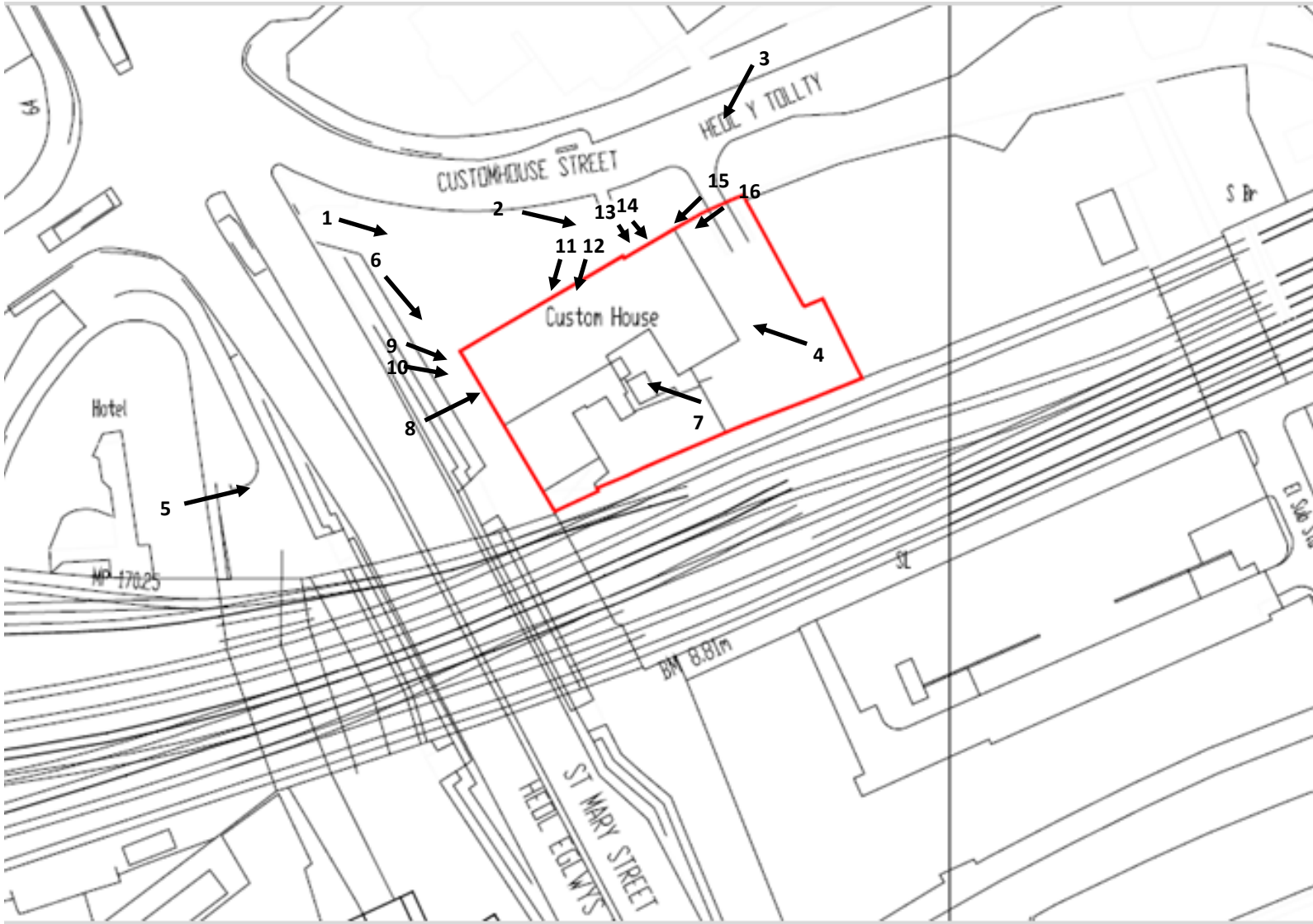

North Elevation

Details	Two storey building with modern hipped Mansard roof above, as viewed from the north west of the Site. Frontage is comprised of stucco with some bathstone dressings. Rusticated ground floor. The north elevation is asymmetrical articulated by banded pilasters into six bays, with windows grouped 3+1+3+1+1+blank.

Details	View of the eastern and northern elevations, from the north east. The eastern elevation is late 20 th century in date and of a plain, utilitarian character. The return of the North Elevation has storeys articulated by channelling in render. The image shows the road infrastructure close to the site.

The west elevation has 5 bays with ground floor central doorway. Corner chimneys, square with cornice. Stone cornice and parapet with inscription 'Custom House'. The image shows the road infrastructure close to the site.
