# Llety Ifan Hen, Bontgoch, Ceredigion

Archaeological Appraisal

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#### **Summary**

Archaeology Wales carried out an appraisal in February 2014 to examine the archaeological potential of a proposed turbine site at Llety Evan/Ifan Hen, Bontgoch, Ceredigion. The proposed development sites on an upland farm near Bow Street, north Ceredigion and is located within the Upland Ceredigion Registered Historic Landscape near the well-preserved Iron Age Hillfort of Pen y Castell.

The field in which the site lies has been used as sheep pasture since the medieval period and has no clear features of an archaeological nature that would be directly impacted by the development. It is possible that the turbine will, however, have an indirect visual impact on the setting of Pen y Castell Hillfort to the south-east.

#### 1. Introduction

In January 2014 Archaeology Wales (AW) was commissioned by Constant Energy Ltd to carry out an archaeological appraisal on a proposed development site of a wind turbine (AW Project Number: 2205; Planning Authority: Ceredigion County Council; Planning Reference: A130816).. The site lies in a field north of Llety Ifan Hen Farm, Bont Goch, north Ceredigion (Fig. 1). This area is within the Upland Ceredigion Registered Historic Landscape: HLW (D) 2 and specifically on the eastern edge of Banc Troedrhiwseiri Historic Landscape Character Area: HLC 64.

This appraisal included an examination of relevant documentary and cartographic sources, evaluation of the relevant Historic Environment Record and a site visit. The work was carried out by Dr Iestyn Jones in February 2014.

#### 2. Site Description

#### Location, Topography, Geology

The site lies in an upland location approximately 4km north-east of Penrhyncoch and 5km south-east of Talybont (NGR: SN 68638 85494; Fig. 1). The nearest settlement is the village of Bont Goch which lies 900m to the north-northwest of the proposed turbine site. A number of other wind turbines are located on hills to the north-west of the proposed site. Although lying within improved pastures the area is characterized as steep upland moor and heathland with bracken, gorse and oak woodlands.

The proposed turbine lies within an east to west aligned sub-rectangular field that is approximately 190m x 290m (Fig. 2). The field rises from north-west (227m OD) to south-east (255m OD). The highest section of the field overlooks Afon Leri that runs south-east to north-west and through the middle of Bont Goch, located some 55m below.

The local geology comprises Devil's Bridge Formation Silurian interbedded mudstone and sandstone underlying freely draining acid loamy soils (BGS 2014; Soilscapes 2014).

# 3. Historical Background

Two Bronze Age standing stones located within 700m to the site (PRN 5419; 8741) testify to prehistoric activity in the area, as does the well preserved Iron Age univallate hillfort at Pen y Castell (PRN 2024), which is also within 700m of the site. Early medieval activity near Bontgoch is suggested by a well dedication to St Padarn. The name Llety Ifan Hen, translated as Old Ifan or Evan's house, lies within the parish of Llanfihangel Genau'r Glyn on land that was a medieval Hafod (summer house) of the Dywarchen (Tir Mynach) Grange associated with Ystrad Fflur (Strata Florida Abbey) (Williams 1990, 57). This upland Hafod was presumably used for summer upland grazing during this period. Following the Dissolution of the monastery in the mid-sixteenth-century it became a part of the Gogerddan estate (DAT 2014). The 1847 Llanfihangel Genau'r Glyn tithe map (Tir Mynach) shows a number of enclosed fields around two farmsteads (Cwm Glo and Llety Evan Hen) and unenclosed Sheepwalk to the east (Fig. 4). The land in this area appears to have been relatively unenclosed and lacked settlements until the mid nineteenth-century when lead mining was at its height. The hillside named Banc Llety Ifan Hen to the southeast of the site was exploited for minerals from the mid-nineteenth century until the early twentieth. The remains of Llety Ifan Hen lead and zinc mine works on this hillside are still visible within 2km of the farm. Llanerchclwydau mine located 850m north-east of the proposed turbine site is know to have been in operation considerably earlier, in the seventeenth-century. The Bontgoch Historic Landscape Characterization suggests that the Lead mining industry provided the stimulus for settlement in this upland area (DAT 2014).

The nearby settlement at Bontgoch has a nineteenth-century nucleus that includes a church, a vicarage and a school.

# 4. Desk-based assessment results

#### 4.1 HER Data

A search of known historical and archaeological sites within a radius of 2 km of the site was conducted. The results are appended (Appendix 1 and Fig. 3).

The proposed site is within the Upland Ceredigion Registered Historic Landscape: HLW (D) 2 and within Banc Troedrhiwseiri Historic Landscape Character Area (HLC): HLC 64. A further seven HLCs are located or partly located within the search area. These are Coed Gruffudd (HLC 89), Pen Rhiw-Newydd (HLC 65), Banc Llewchwedd ddu (HLC20), Banc Llety Ifan Hen (HLC 62), Banc Bwlch Roser (HLC74), Bont-Goch (HLC 75) and Llawr y Cwm Bach (HLC 98).

Three Scheduled Ancient Monuments (SAMs) are within two kilometres of the proposed turbine site. The well preserved Iron Age univallate Hillfort at Pen y Castell (SAM CD069) is the nearest of these and is located approximately 680m south-east of

the turbine site. Banc Troedrhiwseiri Bronze Age Ring Barrow (SAM CD238) is located 1.8km west of the proposed turbine site and two standing stones approximately 90m apart (SAM CD229) are located 1.8km south of the turbine site and south of Banc Cwm-isaf forest.

Approximately one kilometre north-east of the proposed site there are eight Listed Buildings concentrated mainly within Bontgoch. These include Grade II Listed buildings at Plas Cefn Gwyn, Bont Goch (LB 16738; 18879), the former Church School in Bontgoch (LB 10713), the Old Vicarage (LB 18875) and y Felin (Mill) and associated structures (LB 18876, 18877, 18878). The Church of St Peter, Bontgoch, is a Grade II\* listed building (LB 10712). Tabernacl Baptist Church (LB 24020) and Cwm Canol (LB 83662) are located approximately 1.8 and 2.0km to the south-east of the proposed site.

Other sites listed within the HER include a number of former industrial shafts, leats and ruined structures associated with metal mining and clustering to the east at Llety Ifan Hen mine (PRN 9141), south at Llechwedd Helyg mine (PRN 9635), west at Banc Mynydd Gorddu mine (PRN 9134) and north-west at Cefn Gwyn Mine (PRN 9132). Llanerchclwydau Farm, a post-medieval farmstead (PRN 26582) is located 50m below and 360m north-east of the turbine site. Two Bronze Age standing stones are located near Pen y Castell Hill fort to the south-east (PRN 5419 and 8741).

#### 4.2 Map Regression

1847 Llanfihangel Genau'r Glyn Tithe Map (Fig. 4)

The Llanfihangel Genau'r Glyn tithe map indicates a landscape within Tir Mynach (Monk's Land) that was enclosed to the west of Llety Ifan Hen but unenclosed sheep walk to the east (1479). The tithe map, however, shows signs of fading in this area and some boundaries may be missing. The farm, labelled Lletty Evan Hen, is located to the south-east of Cwm Glo which today is directly west of Llety Ifan Hen. To the immediate east of the farm lies field number 1465 named Castell, presumably referring to Pen y Castell Hillfort. This would suggest that the farm in 1847 was further south than its present location. The present farm is located near a building and a field numbered 1474 on the tithe map and named Penybryn House Field in the apportionment.

The proposed turbine site lies within an enclosed pasture field (1476) named Llechwedd y Rhos (The Moor Slope), which is associated with Llety Ifan Hen. Two pathways or tracks are seen to cross the field west to east in the centre and the southeastern corner. An east to west field boundary in the northern end of the field appears to intersect the north to south field boundary in the east and divides a field named Cae Llechwedd y Rhos into two fields, the smaller and more easterly being named Cae Bach (small field) Llechwedd y Rhos. The river Leri forms the northern boundary of this section of the tithe map.

#### <u>1887 OS Map 1:2,500</u> (Fig. 5)

Forty years later the farm has moved 360m north of its location on the tithe map to the site of Penybryn House field. The farm buildings on the new site therefore appear to date from the third quarter of the nineteenth-century. Llechwedd y Rhos appears little

changed although a number of additional foot paths are noted crossing the field east to west and north-west to south east.

#### <u>1980-1981 Epoch map 1:10,000</u> (Fig. 6)

The next discernable change to the field system is visible as late as the late 1970s and is best observed on the 1980-1981 map. It would appear that south of the central east to west footpath seen in the 1887 map Llechwedd y Rhos was divided into three sub rectangular fields. To the north of this footpath two further boundaries in addition to the south-west corner of Cae Llechwedd y Rhos further divide the northern section of the field. The arrows along the east to west northern boundaries presumably represent water ditches that flow north-westwards towards the direction of what was a covered reservoir.

#### **4.3.** Site Visit (Figs. 7 and 8)

A site visit was conducted on the 13<sup>th</sup> of February 2014 on an overcast and breezy day. The field was being used as sheep pasture (Fig. 7a). The area can be described as open and exposed with few trees and, with the exception of Bontgoch, a dispersed settlement pattern. The proposed turbine site is elevated with views to the north and north-west over Bontgoch and beyond (Fig. 7b). Several wind turbines can be seen on hills to the west of the site (Fig. 7c). The land slopes quite steeply to the north, dropping approximately 30m within a 100m towards the Leri river. In most other directions hills and valleys form an undulating backdrop with few houses or settlement visible (Fig. 7d). The boundary of the field is predominantly fenced but an earthen bank and hedgerow is located along the eastern boundary (Fig. 8a). The lack of soil depth is clear on the summit of the raised field where bedrock is visible on the field surface (Fig. 8b). Although a small pine tree plantation provides limited cover on the south-eastern corner of the field the summit of the hillock overlooks Llanerchlwydau farmstead to the north east. Pen y Castell hill fort is clearly visible from the southern boundary of the field nearest the farm entrance to the south-east (Fig. 8c). There were no clear surface indications of possible archaeological features within the proposed turbine field.

# 5. Discussion and Conclusions

This desk-based archaeological appraisal was based on an examination of the historic environment record, (HER) cartographic evidence and a site visit to the to the proposed development area.

The HER record (appended) suggests that the area of the proposed site is an upland moorland used as sheep pasture since at least the medieval period. There is evidence for funerary and possible ritual use of the landscape during the Bronze Age and defended settlement during the Iron Age. This upland landscape may have been sporadically visited during the early medieval period and was the focus for summer grazing during the medieval period. During the post-medieval period the area was exploited for metals, which may have provided a focus for settlement in and around the village of Bontgoch.

The proposed site itself has no features of archaeological interest that would be impacted by the development. It is possible that the turbine would, however, have an indirect visual impact on the setting of Pen y Castell Hillfort to the south-east.






Fig. 1 Location of site











#### SUMMARY

This oval univallate hillfort occupies a local summit or spur at 260m above sea level. Land falls away steeply to the north, west and south, but to the east after falling gently away into a saddle the land rises into the Cambrian Mountains. The internal area measures approximately 100m by 50m, and is defended by a bank and ditch. The circuit is not complete and cannot be traced for about 40m on the south side. Overall the rampart is 12m wide and 3m high, with a slight counterscarp bank. Traces of walling are visible in some locations on the bank face. The entrance is a simple gap at the northeast end.
