151 grave sites recorded

A number monuments had been toppled or had fallen over, perhaps 6 in total and 4 were indecipherable, otherwise the MI was complete.

A TOTAL of 261 persons buried here as indicated by the Monumental Inscriptions - however, possibly another 20 to 30 may also be buried since a number of grave sites could not be accounted for, so just less the 300 people are probably buried here.
